#### What is Dances With Wood?

Dances With Wood is a creative arts program that serves children in hospitals who have life-threatening or life-limiting illnesses. It gives children the opportunity to experience the transforming power of their own imagination and creativity through woodworking projects that can be undertaken while sitting or lying in a hospital bed.

Each project kit comes with a workbook that provides detailed instructions to guide the child through the steps for building the wooden project. Special exercises in the workbook also promote independent learning skills, writing, reading, math, art, and storytelling - all presented with humor and encouragement.
